Whereas John Damron late of the County of Caswell
deceased departed his life intestate leaving a Widow named Mary and
two Infant Children named Eliza & Lewis intermarrying with William
Damon and Martha D. since intermarrying with Alexander M. Damon,
and being possessed of certain Negro Slaves which came to the Hands of
his Administrator The Aforsaid Mary his Widow, and Whereas
she afterwards intermarrying with one William Gold, who hath died, and
since his death the Aforsaid William M. Damon Wife and
Alexander M. Damon and Wife filed their Bill in the Court of Equity for
Caswell County against the said Mary Gold Administrator of
aforsaid dead against Others, and prayed for a Distribution of the
said Slaves and their Increase, and the said Case was removed for
Appeal to the Supreme Court of North Carolina and the said
Court at the last term did adjudge the said Slaves to belong to the
estate of the said John Damron deceased, and liable to distribution
as prayed for; and Whereas the said Mary Gold by her Agent Alexander
M. Damon, and the said William M. Damon and Alexander M. Damon
have chosen and appointed Nicholas Thompson, William A. Sea & James Sea
Commissioners to appraise and divide the said Slaves equally between
them: We the said Nicholas Thompson, William A. Sea & James Sea
have in Pursuance of this Appointment made the following Appraisement
and Division:— The Names of the said Slaves with the Valuations
put on each, is as follows, to wit:

And we do hereby confirm this allotment; and direct that Lot N^o. 1. pay to Lot N^o. 3. the sum of thirty one dollars & Sixty six & $\frac{2}{3}$ Cents
 no 2. pay to Lot no 3. One dollar & Sixty six & $\frac{2}{3}$ Cents
